1. WOOD SCRAP: Recycled for municipal "green energy" generation (1,208 tons in 2010).
2. FLUORESCENT BULBS: Components segregated by recycling service (approximately 650 annually).
3. SAWDUST: Reused in agricultural applications (41.21 tons in 2010).
4. E-WASTE: Recycled for circuits and precious metals recovery (1.1 tons in 2010).
5. PRINTER INKJET CARTRIDGES: Recycled to manufacturer or reprocessor (approximately 75 annually).
6. TELEPHONE BOOKS & CATALOGS: Recycled (approximately 1.5 tons annually).
7. POWDER COATINGS: Reclaimed for Trendway reuse (2.6 tons in 2010).
8. GYP SUM SCRAP: Recycled for agricultural applications. (46.0 tons in 2010).
9. VINYL: Recycled (approximately 1.1 tons annually).
10. BATTERIES: Recycled (approximately 200 lbs annually).
11. BARRELS (STEEL & PLASTIC): Recycled to barrel vendor (approximately 150 annually).
12. WOOD PALLETS: Recycled to pallet vendor (approximately 6,800 in 2010).
13. POLYSTYRENE FOAM: Recycled (0.2 tons in 2009).
14. FABRIC ROLL PAPER CORES: Returned or recycled (approximately 4.5 tons annually).
