Additional Recycled Items *(not included in the figures above)*

1. Wood Scrap: Recycled for municipal waste-to-energy use. (approx. 189 tons in 2007).
2. Fluorescent Tubes/Bulbs: Components segregated & recovered by recycling service (736 in 2007).
3. Sawdust: Reused in local agriculture applications (178.5 tons in 2007).
4. Computers & Electronic Equipment: Recycled for circuits and precious metals recovery (2.6 tons in 2007).
5. Printer & Inkjet Cartridges: Recycled via mail-in to manufacturer or reprocessor (approx. 75 annually).
6. Telephone Books / Catalogs: Recycled (1.6 tons in 2007).
7. Powder Coatings / Reused: (18.8 tons in 2007).
8. Gypsum Waste: Recycled for agricultural applications(43.6 tons in 2007).
9. Vinyl: Recycled (1.1 tons in 2007).
10. Batteries: Recycled (191 lbs in 2007).
11. Barrels (Steel; Plastic): Recycled to barrel vendor(128 in 2007).
12. Wood Pallets: Recycled to pallet vendor (approx. 2,200 annually)
13. Fabric Roll Paper Cores: Returned to suppliers (approx. 4.5 tons annually).
